

Greenland Ice Cap Kiting Expedition Itinerary

Day 1

- Arrive in Iqaluit.
- Review clothing & equipment
- Head out on training trip

Day 2 & 3

- Travel with kites & pulks on Frobisher Bay
- Return to Iqaluit after lunch on Day 3.
- Modify clothing & equipment
- Dinner at your expense

Day 4

- Early morning flight to Kangerlussuaq
- Transfer to the edge of the ice cap
- Start climb through the ice fall

Day 4 to 26

- Travel with ski & kites across the second largest ice cap in the world

Day 26

- Helicopter transfer to Tassilak
- Accommodation at Nansen Hotel (hotel & restaurant food at your expense)
- Day hikes in the surrounding hills

Day 27, 28 (or 29 . . .)

- Charter flight to Iqaluit
- Flights south

Expedition includes:

- Two experienced guides
- All group camping equipment (tents, tent flooring, stoves, cooking gear, first aid, repair & sewing kits, navigational & comms equipment, solar power system)
- Pulks, harness & trace
- Crevasse rescue equipment
- Camping food & camping fuel
- Hotel in Iqaluit, banquet dinner in Kangerlussuaq
- Permits & licenses

Kiting Equipment Supplied:

- 3 Conceptair traction kites (3, 5, 7 meter kites on 30 meter lines)
- 1 Conceptair "First" 3 meter beginner kite sent to you for practice when you confirm your participation on the expedition
- Kiting harness
- If you bring your own kiting equipment, reduce trip cost by \$1,500.

Not included:

- Evacuation insurance of \$200,000 CAD per person (this is mandatory as per our permit with the Danish Polar Center & must be confirmed at least 30 days before start of expedition)
- Hotel & restaurant meals (unless indicated)
- Clothing & Sleeping systems (can rent from NorthWinds)
- Ski equipment (can rent from NorthWinds)
